

Non-Analytic Class of Case: Decision Guide (BASED ON STORE 2026)

Class of Case separates cases into two groups. These groups define the reporting facility's role in managing the patient's cancer. Non-analytic cases include patients who were diagnosed and treated elsewhere and did not receive part of their first course of treatment at the reporting facility.

Ask yourself: Did the reporting facility participate in the diagnosis or first course of treatment?

	33: HISTORY ONLY (NO ACTIVE DISEASE)
SPECIAL SITUATIONS/ NOT REQUIRED BY COC	34: REPORTABLE BY AGREEMENT
	36: REPORTABLE BY AGREEMENT
DX PRIOR TO REFERENCE DATE	35: DX AND TX AT REPORTING FACILITY
DEATH	38: DX AT AUTOPSY

PATIENT DOES NOT APPEAR IN PERSON AT REPORTING FACILITY
40: DX AND TX IN STAFF MD OFFICE BUT NOT AT REPORTING FACILITY
41: DX AND TX IN MULTIPLE STAFF MD OFFICES BUT NOT AT REPORTING FACILITY
42: CASE DX AND/OR TX BY ANOTHER ENTITY (e.g., INDEPENDENT RADIATION FACILITY)
43: PATHOLOGY/SPECIMEN ONLY
49: DEATH CERTIFICATE ONLY
99: NOS, UNK RELATIONSHIP TO FACILITY



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
